The campus entrance is fitted with special ramps, thoughtfully installed by the administrative staff, to facilitate easy access. The building, spanning across three floors, is also equipped with ramp stairs, designed to ensure that disabled students can easily reach their classrooms with the aid of our volunteers or by utilizing our wheelchair.
